

TERMS OF SERVICE

These Terms of Service (this “**Agreement**”) is made between you and Citizens for Responsible Energy Solutions (“**CRES**”), under which you, the user, may use the CitizensFor.com website (the “**Website**”). By using the Website, you acknowledge and agree to the terms and conditions of use set forth below in this Agreement:

(1) **Copyright; Your Use of Content.**

- The Website is protected by copyright as a collective work and/or compilation, under U.S. copyright laws, international conventions, and other copyright laws.
